Kansas Catholics, Politics and the 2024 Election

Catholics are called to Faithful Citizenship, which includes voting. How do we apply our faith and a properly formed conscience to the policy issues of the day as well as our choices for elected office? These are timely and important questions as every seat in the Kansas Senate and House is up for election this year. Members of the Kansas Catholic Conference (KCC), the public policy voice of the Kansas Catholic Bishops, are offering two special presentations designed to inform voters about key issues and where candidates stand. The first presentation is set for 7 p.m. on Mon, Oct 14 at St. Michael's in Leawood. A second presentation is being offered at 7 p.m. on Mon, Oct 21 at St. Patrick's Church parish hall in KC. These presentations will cover what happened this past legislative session at the Kansas Statehouse and information about candidate surveys commissioned by the KCC will be distributed.
