What is Consecration?

1. Consecration in the proper sense is to God and by God, for He alone can divinize, make us in His image and likeness by means of His divine grace.
2. The true ultimate Christian consecration is Baptism, which God gives to us without any merit on our part. Baptism is the beginning of our Christian life whereby God pours His divine life into us.
3. God does not do anything in us or to us without us. It is necessary therefore, that we give ourselves to God and that we ask for consecration.
4. The total giving of oneself in Baptism cannot be better accomplished than by consecrating oneself through Mary.
5. Through consecration, therefore, we unite ourselves with Mary and imitate her who responded to the Will of God in all things, and who was the perfect instrument of the Holy Spirit and the disciple par excellence of Christ
